




Directions: Read the clues and cut and glue the correct bug in the box next to the clue.

Clue #2 / Clave #2:


I have 4 brightly colored wings & eat plants and leaves.

Clue #3 / Clave #3:


I don't have ears & can lift up to 20x my body weight. I am the longest living of all insects.
